## Explanatory notes and criteria for awards

Please read the following notes carefully before completing the application form.

### The Aims of the Fund

The aim of this fund is to provide awards for projects run by community groups based in, or working for, the benefit of people in the town of Bedford. Each award is funded by the Panacea Charitable Trust.

### How much funding is available?

The maximum you can apply for is £5,000. However, the Trustees of the Foundation are able to select four or five projects a year to receive an award of up to £10,000.

### Who or what will we fund?

- The fund will accept bids from projects or groups whose work involves supporting those with mental health issues in one form or another.
- Awards may also be made to projects that address issues of poverty, sickness and education.

### Who/what will we NOT fund?

- Applications from profit making organisations.
- Applications where those benefiting do not live in the town of Bedford.
- Awards will not be made to support the furtherance of any one religion (although we do make awards to community projects led by local religious groups), political activities,

private business (other than social enterprises) or projects that would otherwise be funded from statutory sources.

## **Application and award procedures**

Only requests on the official application form will be considered.

Please make sure that copies of all supporting materials requested are included with the application.

On receipt of the completed application, we will contact you to ask for clarification of any issue if needed and will give the date of the next panel meeting at which the application will be considered.

All applications will be checked against the criteria and those that clearly meet these will be presented to the Awards Panel for their decision. The Funders reserve the right to accept or decline any application according to the decision of the Awards Panel. There is a complaints procedure available to applicants should they feel they have been unfairly treated.

The decision of the Awards Panel will be notified to you within two weeks of the date of its meeting.
