Explanatory notes and criteria for awards

Please read the following notes carefully before completing the application form.

The Aims of the Community Foundation

The Foundation is dedicated to improving the quality of community life of those in Bedfordshire and Luton and, *in particular*, those in special need by reason of disability, age, financial or other disadvantage.

The grant scheme aims to assist community voluntary organisations and groups in Bedfordshire and Luton in new or existing projects that can help make a positive difference in the local community.

How much funding is available?

At present, this is a small grants fund and the maximum grant under the fund will be £500. Due to the small size of grant available, no bids will be accepted from groups with an average annual income of more than £30,000.

Who or what will we fund?

The following criteria apply to all applications. Additional terms may apply to specific funding streams and these will be shown on our web site.

We will fund any organisation (not necessarily a registered charity) which is seeking funds to spend on a project that will benefit those in the local community who are deprived or disadvantaged in some way (e.g. the elderly, the disabled, the isolated, the poor, etc.).

Priority will be given to applications that can clearly demonstrate their work will have a positive impact on the issues that adversely affect their community.

Organisations that have a building society or bank account. Cheques will not be made payable to individuals.

Who/what will we NOT fund?

Applications from profit making organisations.

Applications where those benefiting do not live in Luton or Bedfordshire.

Grants will not be made to support the furtherance of any one religion (although we do make grants to community projects led by local religious groups), political

activities, private business (other than social enterprises) or projects that would otherwise be funded from statutory sources.

Organisations that have not filled in all sections of the Grant application form or answered any subsequent questions put to them by the Foundation.

Applications that do not include all other requested information.

Projects that have already been completed (retrospective funding).

Application and award procedures

Only requests on the official application form will be considered.

Please make sure that copies of all supporting materials requested are included with the application.

On receipt of the completed application, we will contact you to ask for clarification of any issue if needed and will give the date of the next panel meeting at which the application will be considered.

All applications will be checked against the criteria by the Foundation and those that clearly meet these will be presented to the Grants Panel for their decision. The Foundation reserves the right to accept or decline any application according to the decision of the Grants Panel. There is a complaints procedure available to applicants should they feel they have been unfairly treated.

The decision of the Grants Panel will be notified to you within two weeks of the date of its meeting.
